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Comparing Elements Of Story In

Explain to students that fictional texts contain important elements called story elements that enable the story to run smoothly and allow the action to develop in a logical way that the reader can follow. Inform students that these story elements include characters, setting, plot, conflict, resolution, and theme.

For every short story I write, I will start with character, setting and plot then go on from there.
