□ Following the shiva period, the primary mourners (those mourning the death of a parent, spouse, sibling or offspring) observe a period of less-intense mourning known as shloshim. During this thirty-day period it is traditional to attend prayer service at least once a day so that the Mourner's Kaddish may be recited.
