The acolyte's function is to assist the priest and deacon at the altar. This means for the most part that the acolyte does what most of us are used to seeing any altar server do at Mass. The things which only a duly instituted acolyte may do are: Preparing the altar for the Eucharist if there is no deacon present (GIRM 190).

Ministry of Acolyte. In less than one month, I and ...

An acolyte is an instituted minister of the Church; an altar server is not. Lector vs. reader is the same scenario. An acolyte or a lector must be male (cf. can. 230 §1; GIRM, nn. 100-101). An altar server or reader can be male or female, although permitting females to serve at the altar is a decision left to the bishop of each diocese (cf. Redemptionis Sacramentum, n. 47).

The position of altar server involves much less responsibility than the position of acolyte. Acolytes had many duties that have now been broken up and distributed to different people—for example, carrying the cross during the opening processional used to be performed by the acolyte, but now the crucifer fulfills that role.
