Small boats (under 22') you can usually drop the mast easily enough to change the rig on the ground. Medium sized boats (22-36) can usually be done with the mast in the air. Larger boats can sometimes be down with the mast in the air depending on many factors.

When sailing, check the tune in different wind ranges. In light air (0-7 knots) the forestay should be allowed to sag six to eight inches with the backstay eased. In medium air (8-15) the backstay should be applied to reduce the sag to three to four inches. In heavy air (15+) the sag should be as little as possible.

Sailboat Running Rigging Guide Sailboat running rigging is reasonably uncomplicated with headsails [being controlled by sheets] leading from the sail through adjustable fairleads to turning blocks and the winch. The positioning of the fairlead is significant to the performance of the sail, and is particularly so with roller reefing headsails.
